E-mail – messages created, sent, or received by computers.

Internet – a collection of public, worldwide networks including universities, schools, private and public organizations, and other networks.

Network – a collection of individually controlled computers/iPads, printers, modems, and other electronic devices which are interconnected so that they can all communicate with each other.

Spamming – sending annoying or unnecessary messages to large number of people.

Text-encoded files – computer code added to word-processing documents, files, or applications. Commonly referred to as viruses, these codes usually are attached to files for the purpose of altering files and computer hardware setup.
